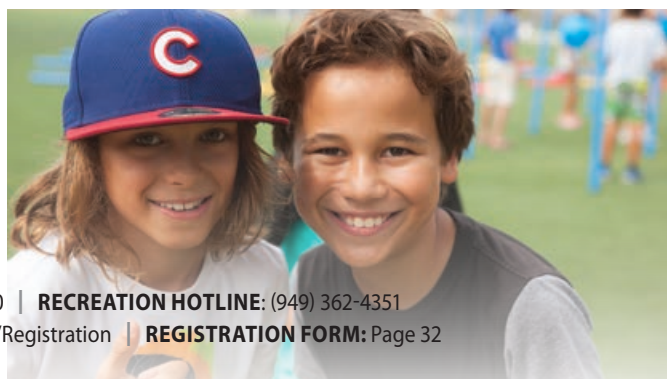
SQUIRRELS

Swim Lessons: Campers registered for M-F (5 days) may sign up for swim lessons for an additional \$30. CVP Aquatics staff will teach two 45-minute group swim lessons on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11-11:45am. Camp staff will escort campers to their lessons and remain on the deck to escort campers back to Squirrels camp.

COYOTES

Activities: Campers will experience outdoor play, board and card games, creating friendship bracelets, ball games, ice breakers, low and high-intensity group games, team-building activities, arts and crafts, swimming, diving, scavenger hunts, dramatic play, karaoke, and Wii games.
