Program Criteria:

- Must be a resident of Laguna Niguel
- Must be at least 65 years of age, or have a disability
- 3. Have a next-of-kin, care taker, or relative as a responsible party.



The "You Are Not Alone" program is designed for Laguna Niguel residents to provide a measure of security and well-being for those who live alone.

This free program consists of checking on the welfare of those residents who have requested it.

Team members (P.A.C.T.) for the City of Laguna Niguel will either visit or make a phone call to the residence twice a week.

If contact with the resident cannot be made, the P.A.C.T. members will call a Deputy to contact the resident's designated emergency contact person, and request that person to check on the resident's welfare.

The YANA program does NOT:

- Administer medications
- Take the participant to the Doctor's office, grocery store, or run errands
