1. [Annual Review of Traffic Controls for School and Suggested Route to Schools Map](#)

- b. *Direct staff to install a bus lane time restriction sign on the existing traffic signal pole on northbound Paseo Escuela;*
- c. *Direct staff to provide copies of the Suggested Route to School maps to the six elementary schools for their use as they deem appropriate;*
- d. *Direct Police Services to continue enforcement efforts in and around the schools.*

2. [Biennial Review of Parking Exceptions on Major and Primary Streets](#)

That the Traffic and Transportation Commission recommend the City Council, make no changes to the ten parking exceptions on major and primary streets.

3. [Request for Parking Restrictions on Danforth Avenue to Increase Sight Distance](#)

That the Traffic and Transportation Commission recommend the City Council:

- a. *Find that adequate sight distance does not exist for drivers making left turns from southbound Sea Street to eastbound Danforth Avenue; and*
- b. *Direct staff to paint approximately 70 feet of red curb on Danforth Avenue east of Sea Street to maintain the minimum required visibility at this intersection.*
