Services with Cabco Yellow Inc. dba California Yellow Cab

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council:

- 1. Approve Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement for Transportation Services with Cabco Yellow Inc. dba California Yellow Cab in the not-to-exceed amount of \$99,750 for the second of two one-year extensions of the Agreement (July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022); and,
- Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute Amendment No. 3 and future amendments to the Agreement for Transportation Services with Cabco Yellow Inc. dba California Yellow Cab, subject to the City Attorney making non-substantive changes.
- 6. <u>Award of Crossing Guard Services Agreement to American Guard Services, Inc.</u>

Recommendation

- Award the Crossing Guard Services Agreement to American Guard Services, Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount of \$220,137 per year for Fiscal Years 2021-22 through 2023-24, subject to extension administratively for two additional one-year periods;
- Approve a not-to-exceed 20% contingency of the total contract in the value of \$44,027 per year for unforeseen conditions or extra work and authorize the Public Works Director/City Engineer to approve additional work with American Guard Services, Inc. for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$264,164 per year if needed; and,
- 3. Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute the Crossing Guard Services Agreement and future amendments to the agreement, subject to the City Attorney making non-substantive changes.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council:
