

1. **Foundation Financial Report**

Secretary Luketich advised anyone with questions regarding the financial documents to contact Committee Member Kelley.

Committee Member McGrath updated the 2019 Car Wash Series finance report with additional sponsors; commended Committee Member Abrams for his gift of supplies.

3. **Minutes of the Regular Military Support Committee Meeting on July 8, 2019**

4. **Reports from the 1st Battalion, 4th Marines, USS Stockdale, and 1st Assault Helicopter Battalion, 140th Aviation Regiment Representatives**

Sabrina King, 1st Battalion, 4th Marines Representative, announced she has compiled the unit's calendar for the rest of the year and will forward to all once completed; noted the unit is currently deployed and expected to return early October; discussed support, activities, and displays planned for the City's 30th Anniversary Carnival; announced proceeds of \$1,675.00 raised by military members.

Committee Member McGrath discussed the preparation and high mark received for a recent inspection of the USS Stockdale; noted training is underway for future Naval officers; announced the ship has been chosen to host a Change of Command ceremony.

Major Dan Goldsmith, 1st Assault Helicopter Battalion, 140th Aviation Regiment, updated the Committee on recent training the Battalion underwent; announced upcoming drill dates; announced the unit will be deployed to Iraq in March 2020 and has started training for this mission. He speculated a good time to have a car wash benefitting the Battalion would be early October, agreed to send a representative to the one on September 7, 2019, for the experience, and agreed to coordinate the best date for the car wash with Committee Member McGrath.
