City Council Selects John Mark Jennings as Mayor and Laurie Davies as Mayor Pro Tem

Laguna Niguel, CA – On Tuesday, December 4, 2018, the Council voted to appoint Council Member John Mark Jennings as Mayor and Laurie Davies as Mayor Pro Tem.

“I am unbelievably honored to have the privilege to serve as your mayor in the upcoming year,” said Mayor Jennings. “2019 marks the 30th Anniversary for Laguna Niguel as a city and its 60th Anniversary as the first master planned city in America. Not only will we celebrate these grand accomplishments all year, I propose that we develop a comprehensive strategic plan for the next 30 years which I am calling “Laguna Niguel: 2050 - the Pursuit of Happiness.” As the fiduciaries of the

Mayor Pro Tem Davies was first elected to the City Council in November 2012 and elected to a second term in November 2016.
