



## 2022 Sea Country Festival Frequently Asked Questions



### General Questions

**Q: When is Sea Country Festival?**

A: Sea Country Festival is a 3-day event starting on Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> and ending on Sunday, August 28<sup>th</sup>.

**Q: What are the time frames for each event date?**

A: Friday, August 26<sup>th</sup> from 5pm-10pm; Saturday, August 27<sup>th</sup> from 12pm-10pm; and Sunday, August 28<sup>th</sup> from 12pm-9pm.

**Q: What kind of access does a wristband get me?**

A: Ride wristbands allow for unlimited use of rides for one person, per day.

**Q: Is the wristband useable for all three days of the festival?**

A: No. Wristbands are good for single day use only for one person.

**Q: Where can I purchase a wristband?**

A: Wristbands will be sold at the Crown Valley Community Center (27951 Crown Valley Parkway), during operating hours, and during some special events, including concert nights.

**Q: When will the concert line-up be announced?**

A: Concert line-ups will be announced before July 2022.

## Community Booth Questions

**Q: How many spaces are available for community booths?**

A: It depends, but we anticipate a total of 32-36 total spaces being available.

**Q: How do I register my booth?**

**Q: Do I have to pay for my booth?**

A: Yes. Please refer to the sponsor, commercial, and non-profit applications for resident and non-resident fees.

**Q: How do I pay for my booth?**

A: We accept checks and credit/debit card payments only. Please make checks payable to *City of Laguna Niguel*.

**Q: I will need access to electricity for my booth. How much does that cost?**

A: There is no additional cost for electricity; however, please make sure you note that on your application. Space with access to electricity are limited and will be offered on a first come, first served basis.

**Q: Is the area where community booths are located lit?**

A: Yes, there will be light in the area where booths are located.

**Q: Will we need to breakdown our booths each night?**

A: No, booths may stay overnight and there will be onsite security to monitor the area; however, materials and other valuables should be taken down and taken with you at the end of each night, as the City nor any vendors are responsible for any lost or stolen items.

**Q: I plan to sell pre-packaged food items at my booth. How do I obtain a health permit from Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA)?**

A: Complete your application to the City for a booth space. Once approved, we will provide you with an OCHCA application and requirements, which must be approved. Your permit must be submitted to the City no later than June 30 for participate in the festival. Visit [OCHCA: Temporary Food Facilities/Food Booths](#) for more information.

**Q: How long will it take to obtain a health permit?**

A: Health permits will take approximately 2 weeks to processes. Please keep in mind OCHCA is busier during the summer events season. Submit application as soon as possible to prevent any delays. **Q: How do I help promote the event to my network?**

**Q: When can I start closing my booth for each festival date?**

A: Community booths can start closing 1-hour before the festival end time. For example, on Friday, August 26<sup>th</sup>, the festival ends at 10pm, thus, community booths can start closing at 9pm. On August 27<sup>th</sup>, booths can start closing at 9pm. Finally, on August 28<sup>th</sup>, booths can start closing at 8pm.

**Q: How will booth spaces be allotted?**

A: Priority will be given to Laguna Niguel non-profits. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Space is limited.

**Q: Will the Sea Country Festival logo be available to sponsors, commercial groups, and non-profits for marketing?**

A: Once your application has been approved, we can email your organization the Sea Country Festival logo upon request for marketing purposes only.

**Q: Do I have to be present for all 3 days?**

A: Yes, community booth participation is a 3-day commitment.
