HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS: GOING OUT OF TOWN?



VISUAL DETERRENTS

- Install motion-activated cameras to cover entire property.
- Install motion-activated lights in front and backyard.
- Set timers on interior lights/electronics, e.g., TV/radio.

PHYSICAL DETERRENTS

- Lock all doors, windows, and garages.
- Install glass break film and/or sensors.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Secure all valuables in inconspicuous locations.
- Avoid posting about your location on social media.
- Ask a neighbor to keep watch of your property.
- Avoid “hiding” spare keys near front entrance.



HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS: PACKAGE THEFTS



PACKAGE SECURITY

- Install security cameras on your front porch.
- Consider installing a parcel box near delivery door.
- Require signature on delivery.
- Take advantage of package tracking.*

**Be aware of fraudulent text message alerts from package delivery companies.*

ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY METHODS

- If your company allows it, ship packages to your workplace.
- Ask a neighbor to pick up your package from your porch.
- Use Smart Package Lockers such as Amazon Lockers.



HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS: DISTRACTION THEFTS



HOW TO PROTECT YOURSELF

- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Suspects work in groups and looking to distract you from your valuables.
- Avoid leaving belongings unattended.
 - This includes wallets, keys, phones, bags/purses in the shopping cart.
- Tell solicitors firmly that you are not interested and walk away.



HOW TO REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

- Notify store manager/employees.
- Call Dispatch* and give descriptive details of suspicious people and/or vehicles.

GIVING IS GREAT: TOP TIPS TO REMEMBER

VERIFY ORGANIZATION LEGITIMACY

- Select popular or well-known charities.
- Check applications such as Charity Navigator to validate lesser-known charities.



QUESTION CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS

- Ask questions when new organizations claim to aid victims.
- Research crowdfunding requests e.g., GoFundMe, to confirm legitimacy.



OTHER TIPS AND SUGGESTIONS

- Keep records of your donations.
- Avoid giving cash.
- Be vigilant for fraudulent emails, phone calls, and social media accounts.



PACT (POLICE AUXILIARY CITIZEN TEAM)

- PACT is a volunteer program comprised of adults residing in the Laguna Niguel area.
- PACT volunteers participate in many programs, including the Vacation Check Program.
- During a vacation check, PACT members visit homes of vacationing residents and ensure property is secure.
